

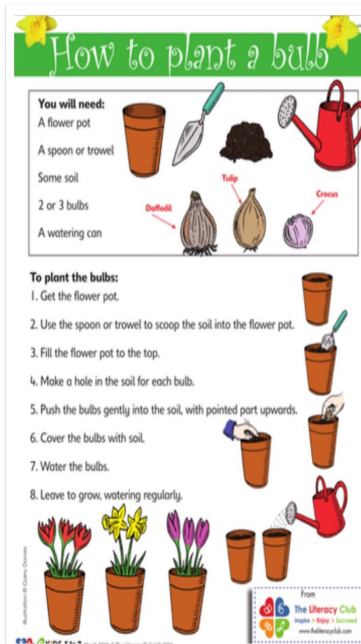

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Learning Challenge:

1. Research how to make a bug hotel

These are the progressive skills that pupils will be covering in these challenges at their own level of learning.

Language and literacy

Writing :

I can draw pictures and make marks that make sense
I can copy and write words

I can talk about what I am going to write
I can write words, phrases and sentences
I can put my writing in the right order and use words: first, second, next, finally
I can use bossy verbs - e.g collect, put, pick, cut

I can write for different reasons e.g set of instructions
I can check and improve my writing to ensure it makes sense

ICT/ DCF

I can research how to make a simple bug hotel.
I can use a search engine to type in key words or a web address.
I can use titles, headings and images to locate the information I need.
I can apply my reading skills to locate the information I need.

STEM task

I can design and build my own bug hotel.
I can discuss the materials I am using.
I can make changes and improve my work.
I can evaluate my finished bug hotel and talk about what I like about it, what went well and how I might change it if I were to build it again.

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
