Think about the food you dislike.

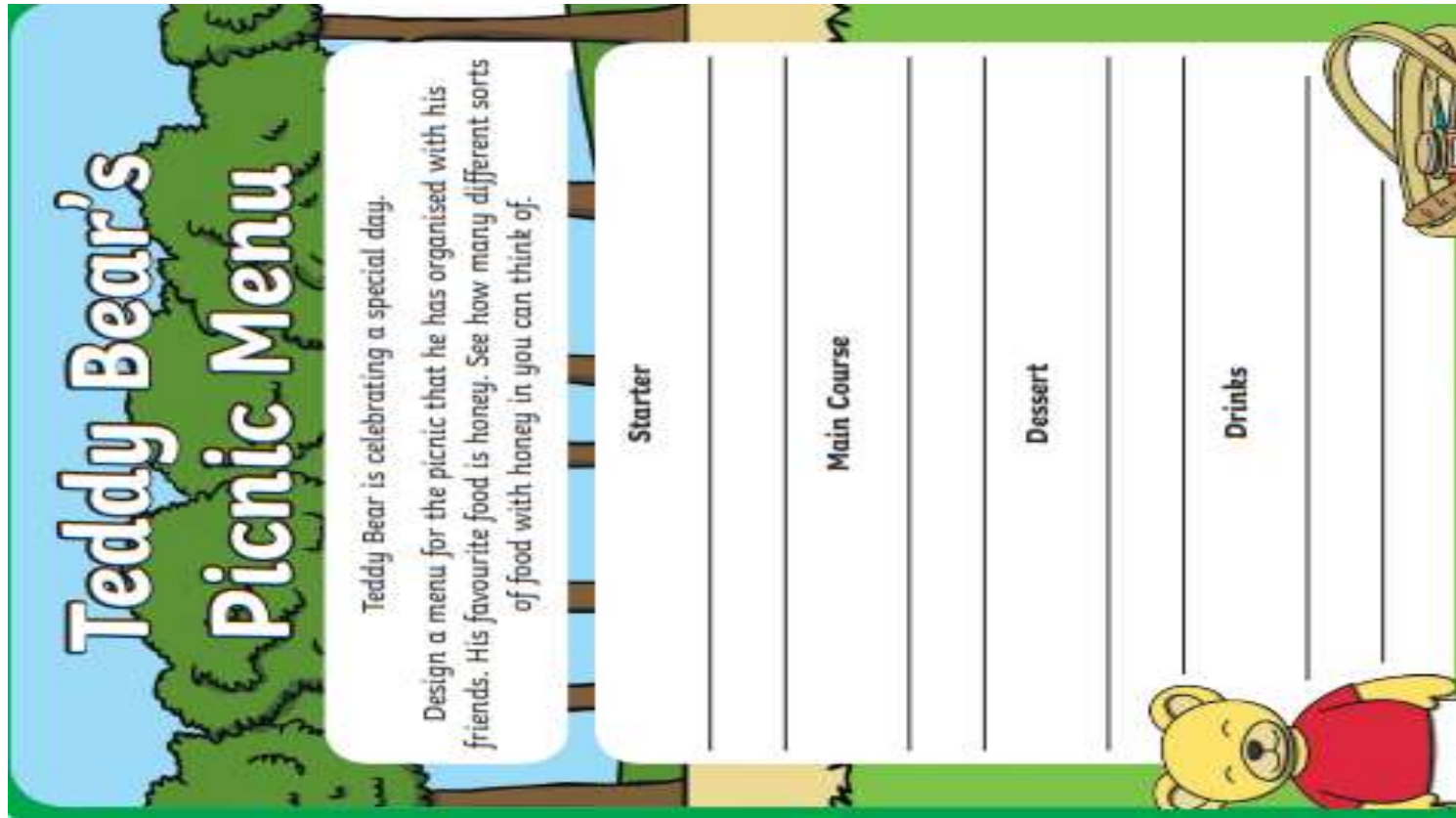

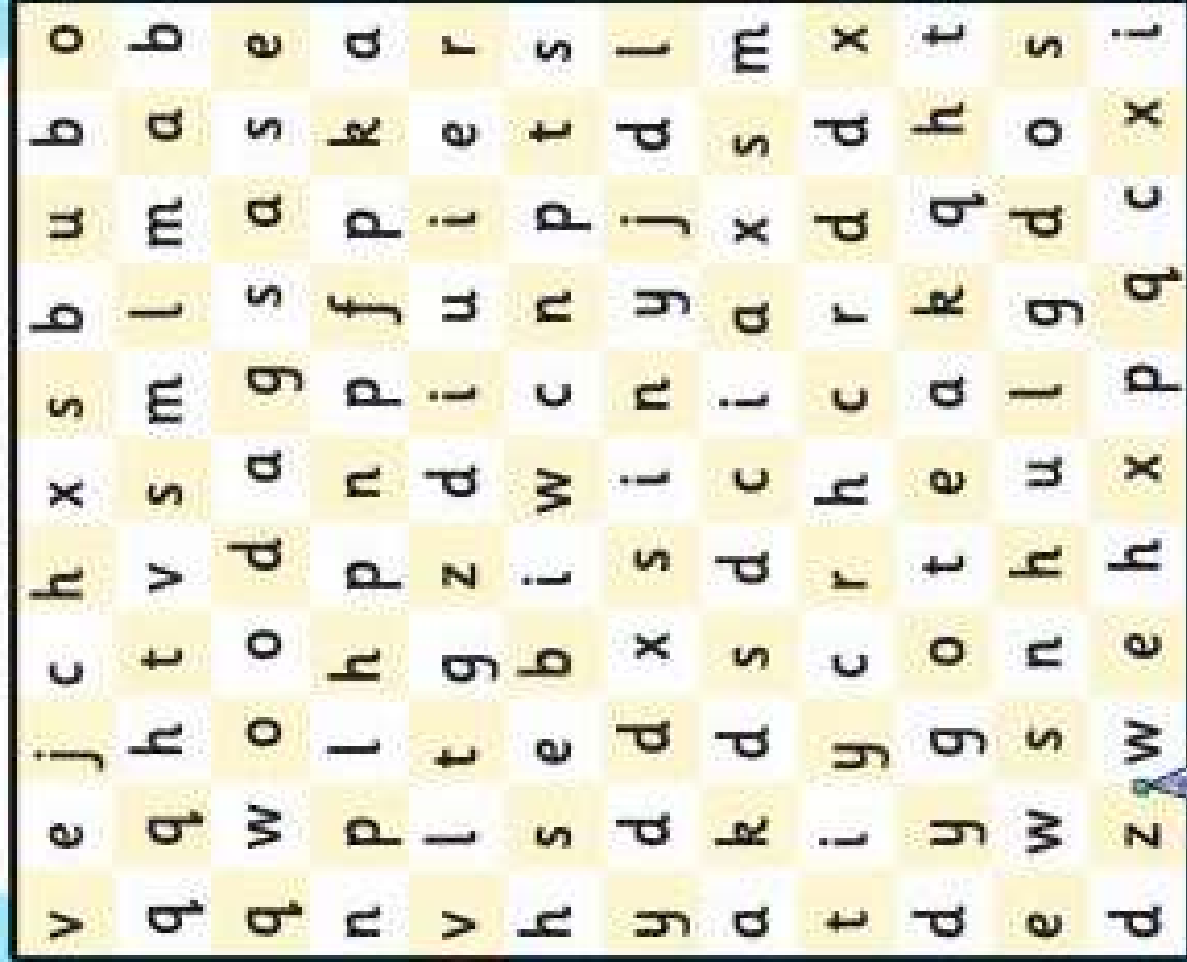
**I can discuss healthy foods.**

Your challenge is to do 20 minutes of moving your body or sport.

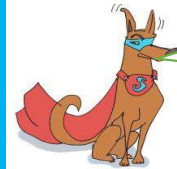
Here are some ideas of what you could do:
